

Skiers Offer to Work To Pay for Cabin Fire

Members of a ski club have offered to work for the county free for about 250 days to pay off the cost of a cabin that burned while they were renting it last year.

The Huggers Ski Club Inc. rented the Churchville Park cabin for a day in September, 1977. About \$12,500 damage occurred when a propane

gas burner reportedly set the cabin on fire.

Representatives of the ski club met with members of the County Legislature's Finance and Budget Committee last week to see if the offer would be agreeable and a court suit by the county could be avoided. The
